

Simplified Supply List for Watercolor

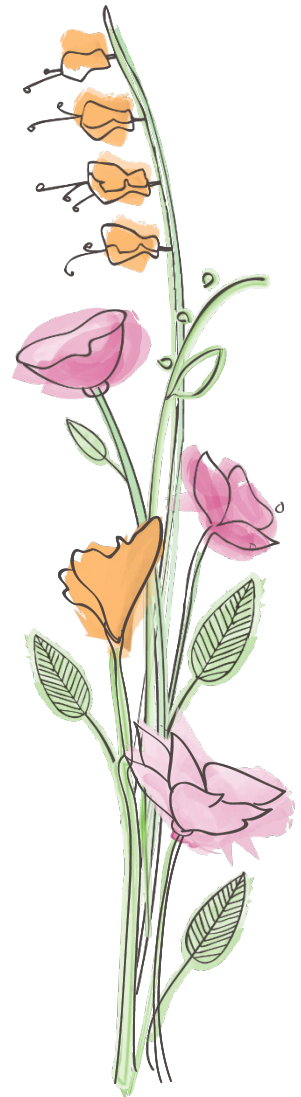

Most, if not all, of these supplies can be found at Amazon, Cheap Joe's, or other art supply stores like Blick.

- Aquarelle Arches pad is a much better-quality cotton watercolor paper 9x12 140lb.COLD press 12 sheets for \$19.00. Or Fingraspuro 140lb. 9 x 12 Cold press 30 sheets for \$20.00.
- Drawing Pencils (H, F, HB, B8). Or RVOGJP TAMATA Professional Drawing set for \$5.00.
- Winsor & Newton Masking Fluid (yellow).
- Royal & Langnickel WAT24 Watercolor Artist Tube Paint, 12ml, Pack of 24 colors for \$15.00.
- Don't spend too much on brushes. You can purchase a "W.A. Portman LTD" set on Amazon for a reasonable price. The set includes flat, filbert, and round sizes in assorted sizes and the case. Or Paint Brushes Set of 24 Pieces Wooden Handles Brushes with a Canvas Brush Case, Professional for Oil, Acrylic, and Watercolor Painting for \$10.00
- Clear Plastic 18" Ruler (Walmart sewing section).
- Blue Painters Tape ½."
- White foamboard comes in large sheets. (Dollar Store).
- A plastic mixing palette (tray), a Masterson Aqua-Pro Watercolor Palette, a Large 32 Well Palette for Mixing Paint, 11.5in x 15.5in, with Lid preferable. \$20
 - A Plastic Container for water, paper towels, scissors, and other items you might have from a previous watercolor class.
